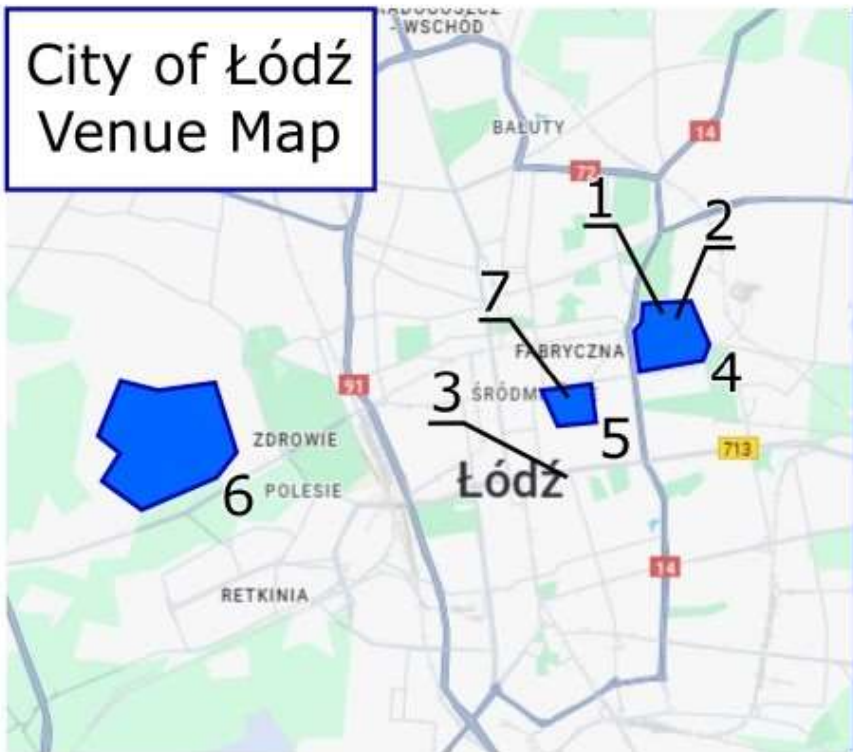

Event Center

University of Łódź (Philological department, Pomorska 171/173, 90-236 Łódź, 51.77669998968774, 19.494938654932618) situated in an immediate vicinity of the dormitories will share the room needed for EUSA offices and the accreditation venue.

Accommodation

Accommodation for athletes is set in dormitories of the University of Łódź, in an immediate vicinity of the AZS stadium – venue for the opening and closing ceremonies as well as finish of sprint stage.

Catering

Athletes accommodated in dormitories will dine in the universities' canteen, which is situated in the immediate vicinity of the dormitories.

Food will be served without any unnecessary waiting. Meat-based, vegetarian and vegan diets are available.

Transport

Arrival and Departure pick-up points will be arranged near airports in Łódź and Warsaw (Chopin's Airport) and on Łódź Fabryczna station.

There is transport to the accreditation venue near AZS stadium and the dormitories will be arranged.

Participants will be able to use the public transport on the basis of shown identifiers free of charge. Travel to the model event and Middle stage will be supported with rented buses.



Classes

Individual competitions (with no qualification):

Women Sprint, Middle Distance

Men Sprint, Middle Distance

Winning times (for both classes): Sprint: 12 – 15 minutes, Middle Distance: 35 – 40 minutes

Sprint Relay Competition

Men/Men MM sprint relay

Women/Women WW sprint relay

Men/Women MW sprint relay

Two runners in one team. Both members of the team run twice. One person can only run in one relay team.

Winning times (per leg) 12 – 15 minutes.

Overall Universities Competition will be counted from individual and relay competitions



Punching system and Time Keeping

SportIdent Air+ system will be used. Competitors can use their own SI Air+ card. For competitors without their own SI Air+ card, it will be possible to rent one without charge.

Eligibility

Participants (according to the EUSA Rules and Regulations):

- have to be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a University or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority or their country, or former students who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in 2024;
- must be at least 17 and less than 30 years of age on January 1st, 2025 (date of birth must be between January 1st, 1995 and December 31st, 2007);
- minimum number of participants from any University or similar institute is 1 (one) competitor. There is no restriction on the maximum number of competitors which can be entered by any University or similar institute.

Rules

The event will follow EUSA Rules and Regulations and Competition Rules for International Orienteering Federation (IOF) foot orienteering events.



Entry fee

75 EUR per person per day, 50 EUR EUSA entry fee per person per event in total:
5 days x 75 EUR + 50 EUR = 425 EUR

The total entry fee includes:

- entry for all competitions,
- accommodation,
- double/twin rooms in student dormitory,
- meal 3 times per day (from Wednesday's dinner to Monday's breakfast),
- transport to all competitions and trainings,
- transport from/to the official airport/railway station.
